Dear Participant,

We are glad that our project has successfully caught your attention. Please allow us to explain the specific steps of carrying out the *student.europe.flow* project through a couple of points and to inform you about your options in case you want to join.

The main goal of the project is to establish relationships between European high school students and their schools. The first step into that direction is to show them the passions of their fellow students from other nationalities, the activities that lead them to the "state of flow". To accomplish this, we are collecting Prezi presentations from the youth of 31 European countries and publishing them on an online platform as part of an international collection of Prezis.

These are the ways you can support our initiative:

IF YOU ARE A REPRESENTATIVE OF A DIPLOMATIC ORGANIZATION OR SCHOOL ASSOCIATION:

- 1) Visit <u>www.studenteurope.eu</u>, the official webpage of the project. There you can find any and all information and contacts you might need to stay informed about the project and get in touch with the organizers, especially with the coordinator in charge of your country!
- 2) Please recommend and share our project among the school principals and students you know, or provide us with their contact data.
- 3) We politely ask you to write us a letter of recommendation on behalf of the organization you represent so we wil be able to send it along to the school principals operating in your country as a sign of your support.

IF YOU ARE A SCHOOL PRINCIPAL OR SCHOOL LIAISON:

- 3) Please recommend our project announcement to your students! Find it attached to this email.

IF YOU ARE A STUDENT:

- 1) Visit <u>www.studenteurope.eu</u> and sign up!
- 2) Pick the activity that best fits this description: *"You're completely involved in an activity* for its own sake. The ego falls away. Time flies. Every action, movement and thought follows inevitably from the previous one, like playing jazz. Your whole being is involved, and you're using your skills to the utmost." This is the activity that makes you achieve what Professor of Psychology Mihály Csíkszentmihályi calls the "flow experience". This activity can be anything, ranging from art, culture and community to sport and science.

- 3) Explain that activity to us through a Prezi presentation you can create one at <u>www.prezi.com</u>. Your presentation may include text, pictures, sound or even a video.
- 4) After logging in, upload your presentation to <u>www.studenteurope.eu</u>, where your fellow European students present their flow activities as well.
- 5) If at any time you should have any questions, thoughts, suggestions or remarks, or in case you need any help connecting with your fellow European students, don't hesitate to get in touch with the coordinator in charge of your country. They speak English, German, French, Italian and Spanish and they will promptly get in touch with you to help you out.
- 6) Join the European flow along with your fellow students from 31 European countries!
